



## **PPE XtraSan**

### **TECHNICAL DATA SHEET**

XtraSan is a complex polymeric biocide in a ready to use aqueous solution providing rapid and ongoing antibacterial and antiviral action on treated surfaces and hands.

XtraSan kills on average 99.9999% of all bacteria tested against.

The product is non-toxic, non-irritant, non-hazardous and environmentally friendly.

Effective against bacteria to BS EN 1276 and BS EN 13697 and against viruses to BS EN 14476.

The active ingredients contained in XtraSan attack protein and lipid structures, including those encapsulating envelope viruses. XtraSan has demonstrated effectiveness against viruses on hard, nonporous surfaces.

#### **Directions**

Use to refill sanitising stations, spray bottles and hand foamers as required.

#### **As a surface cleaner:**

Spray on to surface from a distance of 15-20cm. Leave to act for up to 5 minutes. Wipe away with a damp cloth, sponge or paper towel.

#### **As a hand sanitiser:**

Apply to hands, massage gently and allow to dry, or rinse with clean warm water if required.

Store in a cool dry place away from direct sunlight.
